

# ART IS TO LIVE SCHOLARSHIP

The *Art Is To Live Scholarship* is presented by Olivia Minamyler, a 2013 graduate of Union Local High School. Ms. Minamyler will award a One Thousand and 00/100 (\$1,000.00) scholarship to a senior that intends to further his or her education in the area(s) of the arts; be that the fine arts, music, painting, photography, literature, design, fashion, theatre, cosmetology, barbering, culinary or the many other fields available for self-expression and growth. The scholarship funds are to be used for an accredited school or program that the recipient will attend during the 2018-2019 academic year.

## Eligibility

1. Applicant must be a current student of Union Local High School that is to graduate in May, 2018;
2. Applicant must have applied for, or been granted or notified of, acceptance for admission for the 2018-2019 academic year in an accredited school or program that focuses on the furtherance of a field of study in the arts; be that the fine arts, music, painting, photography, literature, design, fashion, theatre, cosmetology, barbering, culinary or the many other fields available for self-expression and growth. Acceptance and enrollment is a condition to the award of the scholarship funds; and
3. Applicant must graduate from Union Local High School in May, 2018.

The *Art Is To Live Scholarship* will be presented to a qualified applicant without regard to race, sex, religion, age, national origin or sexual orientation. Should it be determined that there is no qualified applicant, the scholarship will not be awarded.

## Selection Criteria

1. Demonstrated or expressed an interest in the arts;
2. Admission for the 2018-2019 academic year granted in an accredited school or program that focuses on the furtherance of a field of study in the arts; be that the fine arts, music, painting, photography, literature, design, fashion, theatre, cosmetology, barbering, culinary or the many other fields available for self-expression and growth;
3. Completed application; and
4. If requested, personal interview.

## Application Requirement

1. Completed application form. (only fully completed forms will be considered);
2. Two letters of recommendation with at least one from teacher or school official;
3. A 500 word essay explaining the applicant's interest in the arts and career goals;
4. Examples of prior works (photographs of prior works acceptable);
